Motorcycle Accident

LBPD Officers responded to the Emergency Room at Memorial Hospital, Los Banos for a 16 year old boy who was injured while riding his Off-Road Motorcycle without a helmet, in the intersection of Birchwood at Cabernet. The juvenile was riding through the intersection when he collided with an oncoming vehicle. The boy was thrown over his motorcycle suffering abrasions to his forehead, left arm and a possible broken ankle.

The juvenile was cited for driving without a license and driving on the wrong side of the road.

With very few exceptions all vehicles must be registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles if they will be operate on the city's streets.

“The juvenile was fortunate he only received minor injuries and that it could have been worse, wearing a helmet is very important.” -Sgt. Elias Reyes.
