At the Crossroads of California

The recent rain and wind events, combined with cooler temperatures, are causing large amounts of leaves to fall in a short time. Public Works is currently working to remove the leaves that are accumulating throughout the city as quickly as possible.

Please follow these guidelines to assist us in providing the best service possible:

- Leaf pickup is the day before your normal garbage pickup day
- Street sweeping is the day after your normal garbage pickup day
- If you do not get your leaves raked into the street in time for your normal leaf removal day, the crews will return (**probably not the same day**)
- Place as many leaves in your **green** waste can as possible
- Rake excess leaves into windrows 2 feet from the curb, leaving enough room around cars for the leaf removal machines to pick them up
- Do not put trash, lawn clippings, or other material in the leaf windrows
- Keep windrows away from gutter to avoid backing up storm water runoff
- Keep an eye out for leaf removal crews working in your neighborhood
