

What's next?

- October 21st - Parks and Rec. Commission meeting
- November / December City Council Meeting



Cal Fire CCI Urban and Community Forestry Grant

Awarded grant for:

- Establish the City of Los Banos' first Urban Forest Management Plan
- Plant 100 trees in the community
- Fund tree care training for staff and provide GIS mapping for trees in the community



Projects must be complete by March 30th, 2024



Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program (SPP)

What have we done?



- In August 2019, Parks and Recreation submitted an application for the Statewide Parks Program grant.
- Submitted design including:
 - Installation of a splash pad and large playground
 - Installation of a Veterans Memorial Wall
 - Installation of lighted basketball and pickleball courts
 - Construction of a replacement Rec. Hall facility
 - Turf, tree, shade, lighting & parking upgrades

Splash Pad Project

- Los Banos Parks and Recreation is completing a feasibility analysis for a future splash pad project!
