- A grant is a funding source from a cooperating agency.
- Grants are offered in many different forms, by organizations such as the Government, Foundations and Non-Profit Organizations.
- The purpose of grants is to make an impact on the area the grant is addressing.

CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS GRANTS

STATEWIDE PARK DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM (SPP)

Since 1965, over 7,400 parks have been improved by State grants. SPP is the largest park related grant program in California's history and possibly U.S. history, with over \$1 billion in funding between the 2008 Prop 68 and 2006 Prop 84 Bond Acts.



WHAT IS THE SPP GRANT?

PARK DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM (SPP)



- The intent of the SPP program is to create new parks and new recreation opportunities in critically under-served communities across California
- Types of projects must involve either development or a combination of acquisition and development to: Create a new park, or expand an existing park, or renovate an existing park

Recreation Features



Eligible examples include:

- Acquisition of land
- Aquatic center, swimming pool, splash pad, fishing pier, or padding launch site
- Amphitheater/performing arts dance, music and theater stage
- Athletics fields and courts
- Community gardens
- Community/Recreation Center (only if it will be in or adjacent to a park)
- Dog Park
- Jogging and walking loop
- Non-motorized trail
- Outdoor gym exercise equipment (fixed to ground)
- Open space and natural areas for public use
- Picnic/Bar-B-Que areas
- Playground and tot lot
- Plaza, Zocalo, Gazebo
- Public art
- Skate park, skating rink, BMX track
- Lighting to allow for extended night time use
- Shade structure/covered park areas
- Restroom building, snack shack
- Parking lot, staging area, pathway access
- Landscaping or lighting


CENTER STAGE COMMUNITY BUILDING






