**USING MEASURE V REGIONAL FUNDING,
DESIGN ON THE PACHECO BOULEVARD
REGIONAL PATH HAS STARTED**

LOS BANOS, CA – The regional revenue generated from Measure V from Los Banos has been allocated to be used for the design and construction of a bike/pedestrian path from Badger Flat Road to the Merced College Los Banos Campus.

This 10 foot path will be on the northerly side of State Route 152, and will have lighting and landscaping.

The engineering work for the design of the path has already begun with the start of preliminary right of way establishment.

“This has been a long awaited project that will provide a safe path to the local college, said Public Works Director/City Engineer Mark Fachin. He continued, “Measure V has provided the necessary required funding source to construct this very needed improvement.”

Construction of this path is scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2022 and be completed by the end of 2022.

This \$2.2 million dollar project is 100% funded by Measure V Regional Funds.
