

## Out of Town Business License Application Submittal Requirements

- Completed Application
  - Specify Business License duration:
    - Annual – for a period of 12 months
    - Short Term – for a period of 3 months or 6 months; no more than one short term business license shall be issued in a 12 month period to the same licensee.
    - Temporary – for a period of 3 consecutive days or less; no more than 6 temporary business licenses shall be issued in a 12 month period to the same licensee.
- Business License Operational Statement
- Business License fee – see fee schedule for applicable fees
- For Veterans, proof of Form DD-214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty issued by the United States Department of Defense, if applicable
- Color copy of a valid State-issued Driver's License/Identification Card for each Business Owner listed on the Business License application
- Copy of a valid Fictitious Business Name Statement and/or Articles of Incorporation/ Organization, if applicable
- Copy of a Seller's Permit, if applicable
- Copy of a Health Permit, if applicable
- Proof of Coverage under Industrial General Permit [i.e. document with Waste Discharger Identification (WDID) number], if applicable
  - See Attachment A. Businesses operating under specific Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes (generally those between 0211 and 5171) must obtain coverage under the State Water Resource Control Board's (SWRCB) General Industrial Stormwater Permit. For more information and specific requirements, visit [www.waterboards.ca.gov](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov).
- Proof of completed Livescan and/or drug testing thru Los Banos Police Department, if applicable
- Other required licenses, permits, and/or registrations, if applicable

**Note:** Staff may deem additional submittal information necessary. Paper applications with original business owner signature must be submitted to the address on the application. Make checks and money orders payable to: City of Los Banos. Incomplete or illegible applications will delay the processing and issuance of the business license. Once the Business License application has been reviewed, processed, and verified, the Business License will be mailed to the address listed on the application. Please allow at least two weeks from the date received in order to check the status of the Business License application.



## Welcome to Los Banos, as a Business Opportunity!

To assist you in getting started, please note the following information that should be examined prior to opening your business. We hope that in reviewing this, we may better assist your efforts to get your business open in a timely manner.

Please visit the "Doing Business" tab at [www.losbanos.org](http://www.losbanos.org) for useful resources and information about starting a business and applying for a City Business License. We invite your questions about any of the subjects listed below. Please contact the Community & Economic Development Department by email at [businesslicenses@losbanos.org](mailto:businesslicenses@losbanos.org) for assistance.

1. Once you turn in your application for a Commercial Business License, you can sign up for water/utility services at the commercial location with the Finance Department. There is a "lead time" necessary for establishing new garbage pick-up service.
2. Your commercial business location must be inspected and be in compliance with applicable zoning, fire, and building codes and safety requirements before your Business License can be issued.
3. Is your proposed business location appropriately zoned for the use you have chosen? Please be sure to check with the Community & Economic Development Department prior to renting or leasing your proposed location.
4. The Los Banos Municipal Code requires adequate parking for your business. Have you checked to determine if the number of parking spaces on the site is adequate for your proposed use? Please be sure to check with a Planner in the Community & Economic Development Department prior to renting or leasing your proposed location.
5. Before starting your business, you must be in possession of a Business License issued by the City (receipts do not count), and it must be conspicuously posted upon the business premises or on your person when lawfully conducting a mobile business.
6. If your business includes the sale of alcoholic beverages, you must first obtain a Conditional Use Permit from the Community & Economic Development Department and an ABC License from the California Department of Alcohol and Beverage Control.
7. If you have employees, you must have workers' compensation insurance.
8. The Los Banos Municipal Code requires Sign Reviews and sometimes Building Permits for permanent and temporary signage. The Sign Ordinance regulates sign sizes and locations, so please check with the Community & Economic Development Department and the Building Department before installing.
9. Before occupancy can be granted for newly completed commercial/industrial buildings, all special Conditions of Approval for Site Plan Reviews and Conditional Use Permits must first be complied with or bonded for.
10. Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public. ### FACILITIES COVERED BY NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) GENERAL PERMIT FOR STORM WATER DISCHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITIES (GENERAL PERMIT)

1. Facilities Subject To Storm Water Effluent Limitations Guidelines, New Source Performance Standards, or Toxic Pollutant Effluent Standards Found in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Subchapter N (Subchapter N):  
  
Cement Manufacturing (40 C.F.R. Part 411); Feedlots (40 C.F.R. Part 412); Fertilizer Manufacturing (40 C.F.R. Part 418); Petroleum Refining (40 C.F.R. Part 419), Phosphate Manufacturing (40 C.F.R. Part 422), Steam Electric (40 C.F.R. Part 423), Coal Mining (40 C.F.R. Part 434), Mineral Mining and Processing (40 C.F.R. Part 436), Ore Mining and Dressing (40 C.F.R. Part 440), Asphalt Emulsion (40 C.F.R. Part 443), Landfills (40 C.F.R. Part 445), and Airport Deicing (40 C.F.R. Part 449).
2. Manufacturing Facilities:  
  
Facilities with Standard Industrial Classifications (SICs) 20XX through 39XX, 4221 through 4225. (This category combines categories 2 and 10 of the previous general permit.)
3. Oil and Gas/Mining Facilities:  
  
Facilities classified as SICs 10XX through 14XX, including active or inactive mining operations (except for areas of coal mining operations no longer meeting the definition of a reclamation area under 40 Code of Federal Regulations. 434.11(1) because the performance bond issued to the facility by the appropriate Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Acts authority has been released, or except for areas of non-coal mining operations which have been released from applicable State or Federal reclamation requirements after December 17, 1990) and oil and gas exploration, production, processing, or treatment operations, or transmission facilities that discharge storm water contaminated by contact with or that has come into contact with any overburden, raw material, intermediate products, finished products, by-products, or waste products located on the site of such operations. Inactive mining operations are mining sites that are not being actively mined, but which have an identifiable owner/operator. Inactive mining sites do not include sites where mining claims are being maintained prior to disturbances associated with the extraction, beneficiation, or processing of mined material; or sites where minimal activities are undertaken for the sole purpose of maintaining a mining claim.
4. Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage, or Disposal Facilities:  
  
Hazardous waste treatment, storage, or disposal facilities, including any facility operating under interim status or a general permit under Subtitle C of the Federal Resource, Conservation, and Recovery Act.
5. Landfills, Land Application Sites, and Open Dumps:  
  
Landfills, land application sites, and open dumps that receive or have received industrial waste from any facility within any other category of this Attachment; including facilities subject to regulation under Subtitle D of the Federal Resource, Conservation, and Recovery Act, and facilities that have accepted wastes from construction activities (construction activities include any clearing, grading, or excavation that results in disturbance).
6. Recycling Facilities:  
  
Facilities involved in the recycling of materials, including metal scrapyards, battery reclaimers, salvage yards, and automobile junkyards, including but limited to those classified as Standard Industrial Classification 5015 and 5093.
7. Steam Electric Power Generating Facilities:  
  
Any facility that generates steam for electric power through the combustion of coal, oil, wood, etc.
8. Transportation Facilities:  
  
Facilities with SICs 40XX through 45XX (except 4221-25) and 5171 with vehicle maintenance shops, equipment cleaning operations, or airport deicing operations. Only those portions of the facility involved in vehicle maintenance (including vehicle rehabilitation, mechanical repairs, painting, fueling, and lubrication) or other operations identified under this Permit as associated with industrial activity.
9. Sewage or Wastewater Treatment Works:  
  
Facilities used in the storage, treatment, recycling, and reclamation of municipal or domestic sewage, including land dedicated to the disposal of sewage sludge, that are located within the confines of the facility, with a design flow of one million gallons per day or more, or required to have an approved pretreatment program under 40 Code of Federal Regulations part 403. Not included are farm lands, domestic gardens, or lands used for sludge management where sludge is beneficially reused and are not physically located in the confines of the facility, or areas that are in compliance with Section 405 of the Clean Water Act.
