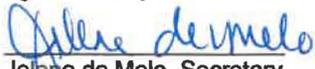

PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 15, 2019**

ACTION MINUTES – These minutes are prepared to depict action taken for agenda items presented to the Parks and Recreation Commission.

CALL TO ORDER: Chairperson Harper called the Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Chairperson Harper led the pledge of allegiance.

ROLL CALL – MEMBERS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION PRESENT: Dominguez, Irwin, Harper; Flores excused, Munoz absent.

STAFF MEMBERS PRESENT: Public Works Director/City Engineer Fachin, Parks & Recreation Operations Manager Heim, Administrative Coordinator de Melo.

CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion by Irwin, seconded by Dominguez to approve the agenda as submitted. The motion carried by the affirmative vote of all Parks and Recreation Commission Members present; Flores excused, Munoz absent.

CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF THE ACTION MINUTES FOR THE REGULAR MEETING OF APRIL 16, 2019: Motion by Irwin, seconded by Dominguez to approve the agenda as submitted. The motion carried by the affirmative vote of all Parks and Recreation Commission Members present; Flores excused, Munoz absent.

PUBLIC FORUM: MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC MAY ADDRESS THE COUNCIL ON ANY ITEM OF PUBLIC INTEREST THAT IS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY; INCLUDES AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS. NO ACTION WILL BE TAKEN ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS. DETAILED GUIDELINES ARE POSTED ON THE COUNCIL CHAMBER INFORMATIONAL TABLE. No one came forward to speak, and the Public Forum was closed.

PARKS & RECREATION 2019/2020 REVENUE/EXPENDITURE REPORT: Public Works Director/City Engineer Fachin reported we are 25% into the budget year, and the budget is on track. Most of our revenue is collected at the end of the fiscal year, due to soccer sign ups. Insurance is paid in the beginning of the fiscal year. We have hired 2 additional full time Recreation staff members, and have increased the number of activities we have to offer the public.

COMMUNITY CENTER OPEN GYM STANDARDS OF CONDUCT ESTABLISHMENT. Parks & Recreation Manager Heim reviewed the recently established Standards of Conduct for the Community Center Open Gym.

PARKS & RECREATION OPERATIONS MANAGERS REPORT. Parks & Recreation Operations Manager Heim discussed Measure H funding, and the programs we were able to add due to Measure H support. We are also able to offer activities at a lower cost, due to the financial support of Measure H. We have partnered with 4-H to offer Stem Classes, which is exciting. We have our first Party in the Park scheduled this Saturday at Ranchwood Park. All Commissioners are welcome to attend. Measure H has also put money towards capital projects, including improving some of our parks. Skylark Park playground (which previously burned down) has been installed recently. Big Page Park playground is scheduled to be replaced next. Chairperson Harper commented that in the two terms she has served, she is excited about where the Recreation Program is going and where the Parks Program is going. After attending recent Commission Meetings, she feels confident that we are doing the best we can for Los Banos and our community. Thanked staff for all they are doing, and feels this is a huge improvement.

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR/CITY ENGINEER REPORT. Public Works Director/City Engineer Fachin reported 13 months ago, we had put together a list of parks that had dangerous situations, and we are down to only 2 left for repairs. Half of our parks are funding by landscape and lighting districts, which were financially burdened due to the economic downturn. We are still in the process of getting the districts caught up. We have been able to fix up some of our medians in areas, as the districts can financially afford it. We are continuing our water conservation efforts. We are beginning to update our Parks Master Plan, which will be completed in 2020. We will be asking Commissioners to participate with input for the plan. We are mandated to put in a Dog Park by the end of this fiscal year. We are considering the Ag Sports Complex as the location.

COMMISSION MEMBER REPORTS.

DOMINGUEZ: Over the last 2 years, we have improved our Recreation Guide. How are we distributing them to the public? Operations Manager Heim stated copies are available at the Community Center, City's website, Facebook, street fairs, and community events. It is not cost effective to mail out or distribute the activity guide to the schools, however, we do a monthly newsletter that does get distributed to all the elementary schools in our district. We are now collecting email addresses during registration, and will do email blasts in the future.

FLORES: Excused.

IRWIN: Thanked Joe for being responsive, noticed the work in the parks; the park near his house has seen a lot more basketball activity, including people who normally frequent larger parks. Concerned with the trees in Gardens Park. Some of the aging trees look overgrown and stressed. Operations Manager Heim stated that Gardens Park is a general fund park, and those trees are on the list to be addressed when there is funding for it. Questioned if the court lines will be painted during events such as Party in the Park. Operations Manager Heim stated that we will not wait for Party in the Park to paint court lines; we can do that on an as needed basis.

MUNOZ: Absent.

HARPER: Asked if there was a diversity report, or any statistics or data? Do we know who is attending our events? There seems to be an inclusion problem. Operations Manager Heim responded that we do not ask for race, income, ethnicity, etc. during the registration process, therefore, we do not have a way to track that info. We are trying to incorporate bilingual translation of our activity guides. We are also looking for different locations for activities around town to attract different types of people. Chairperson Harper suggested using a text message method of trying to reach more people with activity information. Operations Manager Heim said we will definitely look into text messages in the future. Director/City Engineer Fachin stated we are also working with the Boys and Girls Club to find a location, because this organization is great at serving the underserved members of our community. Commissioner Dominguez suggested taking registration at various events where the City may have a booth. Operations Manager Heim stated that we currently do not have software/internet to support taking registration out in the field, but that may be an option in the future.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at the hour of 6:54 p.m.

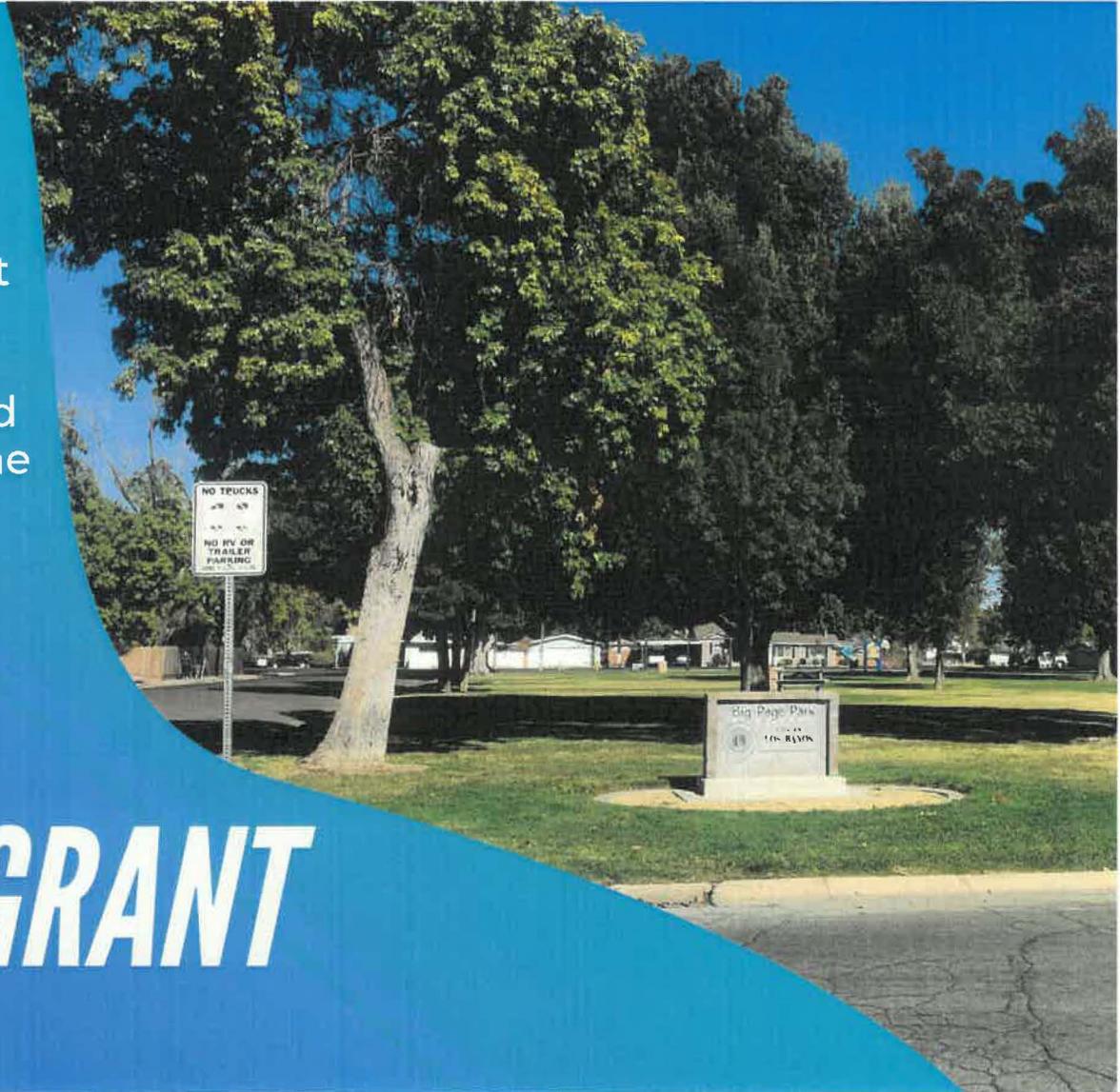
In August 2019, Parks and Recreation submitted an application for the Statewide Parks Program grant.
