LOS BANOS, CA – With the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) encouraging the public to stay home if they are currently sick, showing symptoms, have knowingly been exposed to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), or have recently traveled to an infected area, and consistent with the County's Interim Guidance for Social Distancing, the City of Los Banos is taking precautionary steps to ensure the public access to the March 18, 2020 City Council meeting while limiting opportunities for COVID-19 to spread.
